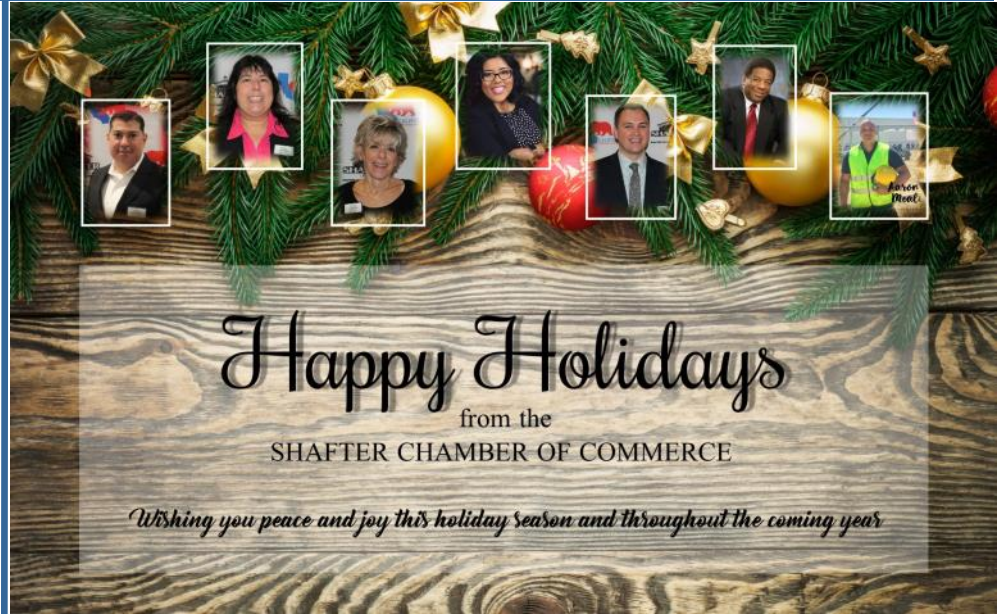

NEW CALIFORNIA STATE LAWS effective January 1, 2022

Key New California Laws for 2022 (and Beyond): What Employers Should Know

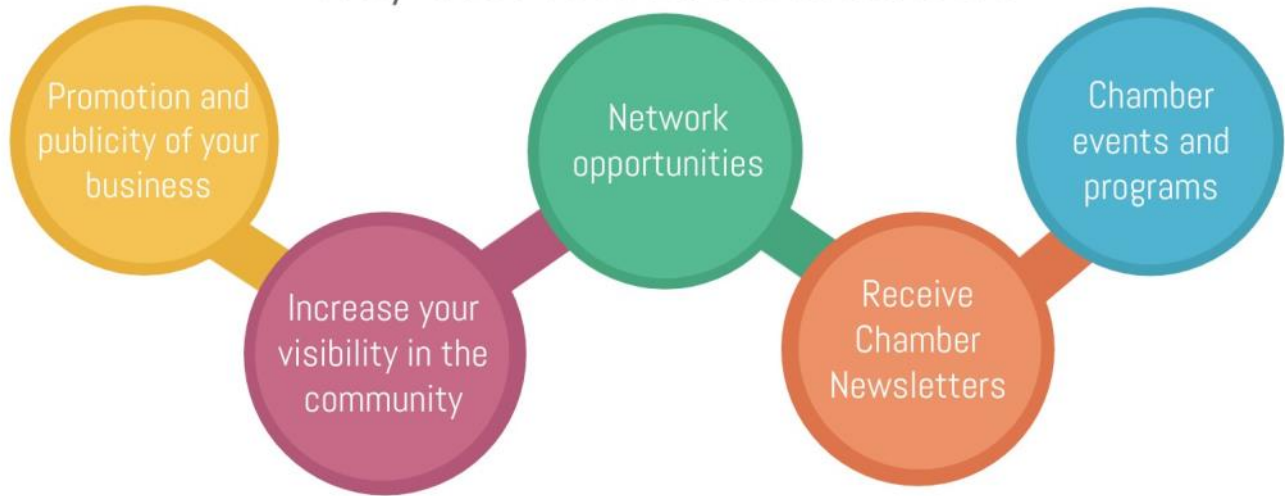
In 2021, Governor Newsom signed several laws impacting California employers. A list is provided below of the key new laws, some of which recently became effective and some will take become effective January 1, 2022. The foregoing new laws will require employers to revise their policies and procedures. Employers should consult with legal counsel to ensure their policies are compliant and their employee handbooks are up to date.

- AB 73 – PPE Requirements for Wildfire Smoke Events & Agricultural Workers (Effective September 27, 2021)
- AB 654 – COVID-19 Exposure Notification (Effective October 6, 2021)
- AB 701 – Regulation of Production Quotas in Warehouse Distribution Centers (Effective January 1, 2022)
- AB 1003 – Wage Theft (Effective January 1, 2022)
- AB 1023 – Electronic Records for Contractors and Subcontractors (Effective January 1, 2022)
- AB 1033 – California Family Rights Act (Effective January 1, 2022)
- AB 1506 – AB 5 Exemption for Newspaper Distributors & Carriers (Extended to January 1, 2025)
- AB 1561 - Classification of Independent Contractors (Generally Extends and/or Revises Certain Employees)
- SB 331 – Silenced No More Act: Settlements & Non disparagement Agreements (Effective January 1, 2022)
- SB 606 – Workplace Safety: Enterprise-Wide & Egregious Health & Safety Violation (Effective January 1, 2022)
- SB 646 – PAGA Exemption for Janitorial Employers Working Under a CBA (Effective January 1, 2022)
- SB 657 – Electronic Delivery of Workplace Notices (Effective January 1, 2022)
- SB 727 – Direct Contractor Liability (Effective January 1, 2022)
- SB 762 – Timing of Fees & Costs Due in Arbitration (Effective January 1, 2022)
- SB 807 – DFEH: Enforcement of Civil Rights (Effective January 1, 2022)
